

THE AFTER HOURS FILM SOCIETY

INVITES YOU TO ENTER THE 2010 STUDENT SHORT FILM AND VIDEO FESTIVAL

Welcome to the seventh annual student film festival hosted by the After Hours Film Society, a not-for-profit organization dedicated to the appreciation of cinema, both as an art form and as a medium of information and education. Our mission is to inspire, encourage, recognize and promote the work of student filmmakers. Entries are open to all students everywhere and will be judged by film professionals and educators who have a knowledge of and respect for creativity, originality, ambition and determination.

GUIDELINES

1. Festival entries are open to all students.
2. All films/videos must be submitted in the English language. If produced in languages other than English, they must be subtitled or dubbed.
3. Eligible entries may not exceed 30 minutes in length.
4. All genres accepted. (Fiction, Non-fiction, Animation/Experimental)
5. Entries may be made in any format but must be submitted on 1/2" VHS or DVD for jury screening.
6. Films must have been completed between January, 2005 and June, 2010 while the filmmaker was a full or part-time student of amateur status. No paid commercial, theatrical or TV releases will be accepted.
7. Postmark entry deadline: June 30, 2010.
8. Winners will be selected by a panel of film educators and professionals.
9. Winners agree to participate in the publicity for the After Hours Film Society as well as other promotional events including the AHFS web site.
10. First Place, Second Place and Honorable Mention winners will be screened at a special After Hours program. The judges have the right to decide to show a portion of a film rather than the entire film if time becomes an issue. In order to preserve the integrity of the film, a winning student may be asked to submit an edited version.
11. The determination of the winners is final.

RULES

1. Applicants must submit completed and signed entry application with \$10 fee (early bird entry fee of \$5.00 for films postmarked on or before March 31, 2010.) and VHS/DVD to the After Hours Film Society, Post Office Box 3534, Glen Ellyn, IL 60138-3534, postmarked no later than June 30, 2010. (Entry fees are non-refundable.)
2. Each video or DVD should be labeled clearly with applicant's name, address, phone number, film title and running time.

- A self-addressed stamped postcard for verification of receipt of entry.
- A brief bio of filmmaker(s).
- Photocopy of Student ID
- Synopsis of film/filmmaker's statement.
- To guarantee the return of tape or DVD, a self-addressed, stamped envelope must accompany entry. In absence of this, the tape or DVD will not be returned.
- It is the responsibility of the entrant to notify the After Hours Film Society in the event of a change in phone number, mailing or e-mail address. Should the entrant win an award and not forward the change, every attempt will be made to locate the entrant, but delivery cannot be guaranteed and the prize will be forfeited.
